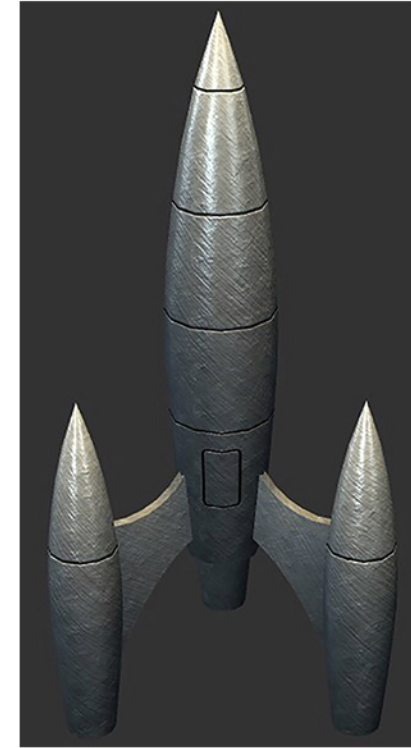
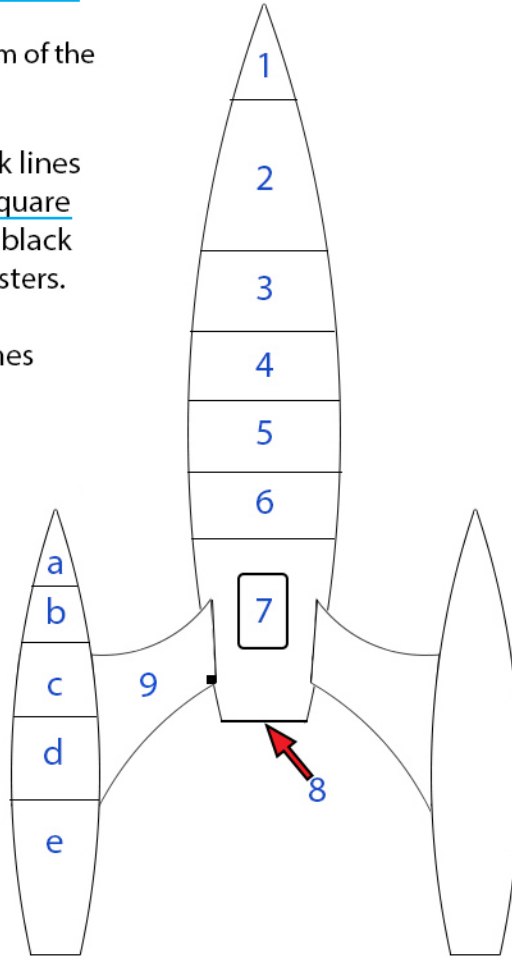
# Retro Rocket 1

Keep ALL seams aligned when gluing the rocket together.

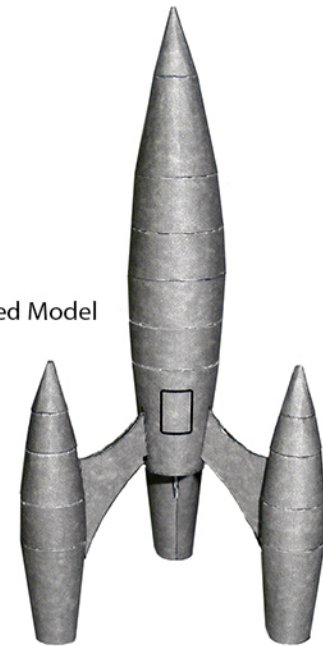
Part 8 is glued over the small opening at the bottom of the rocket (Part 7).

Glue the larger end of the fins (9) onto the black lines on each of the three boosters (a-e). The black square on the other end should be at the bottom. The black lines are located on the glue seams on the boosters.

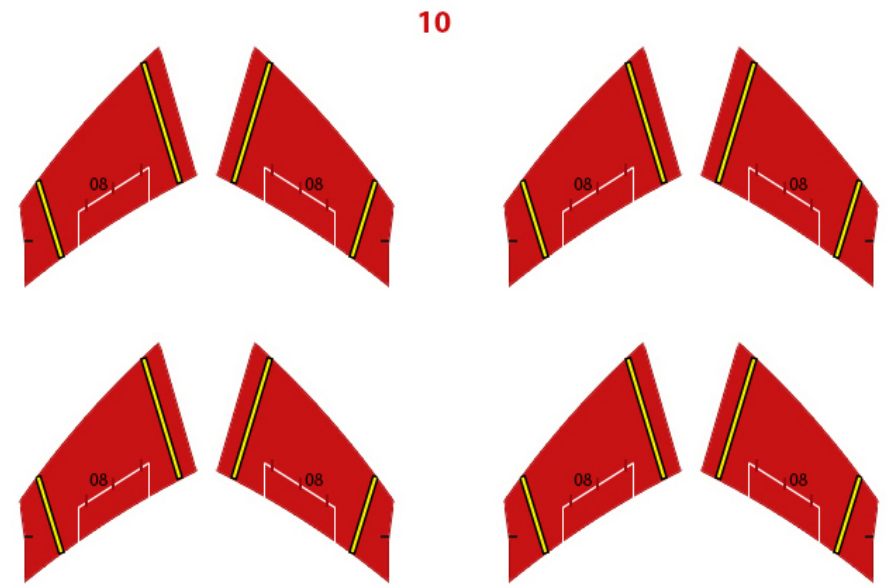
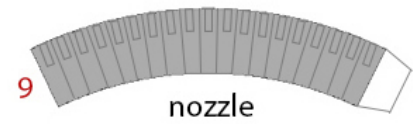
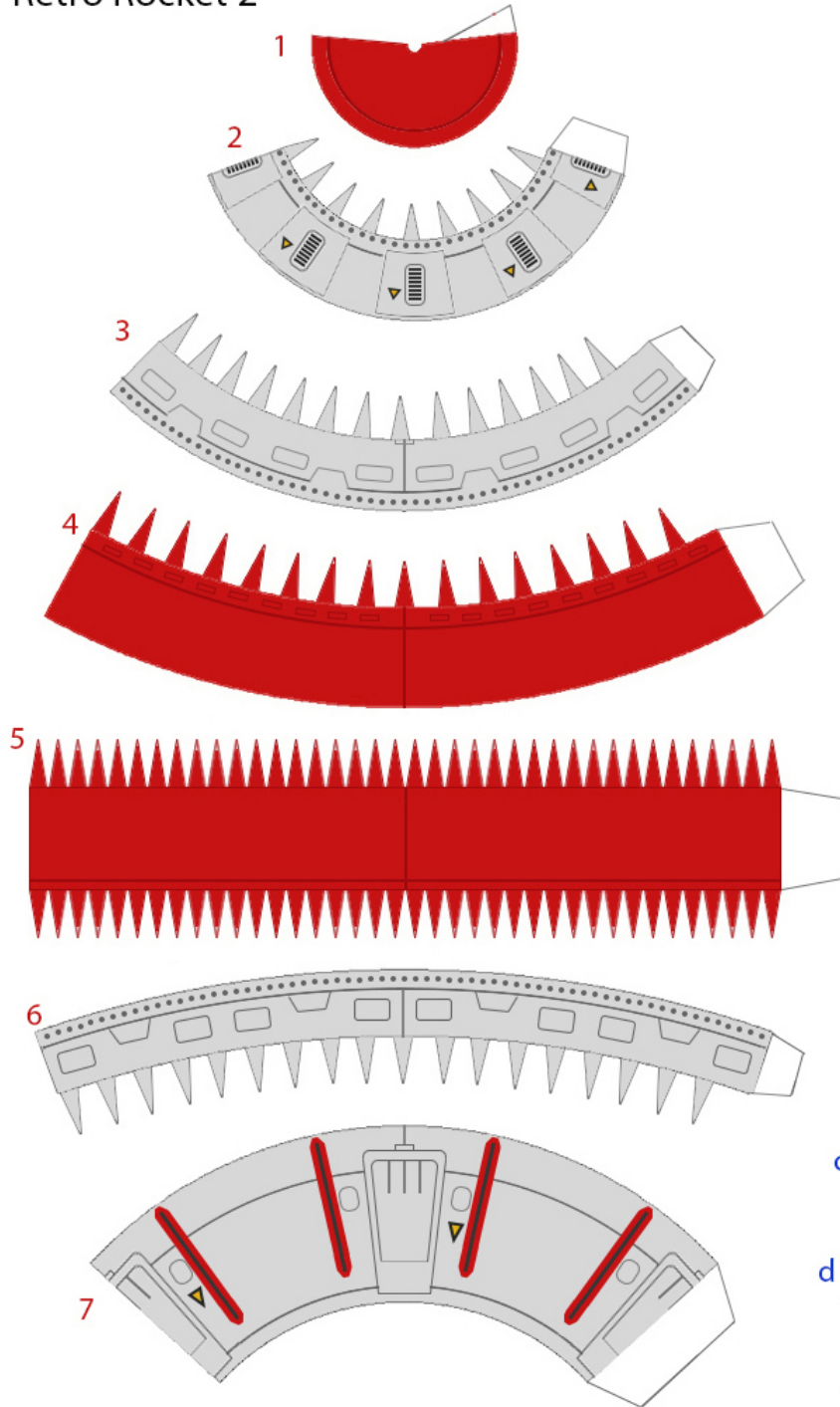
Glue the other end of the fins onto the black lines near the bottom of the rocket (Part 7).



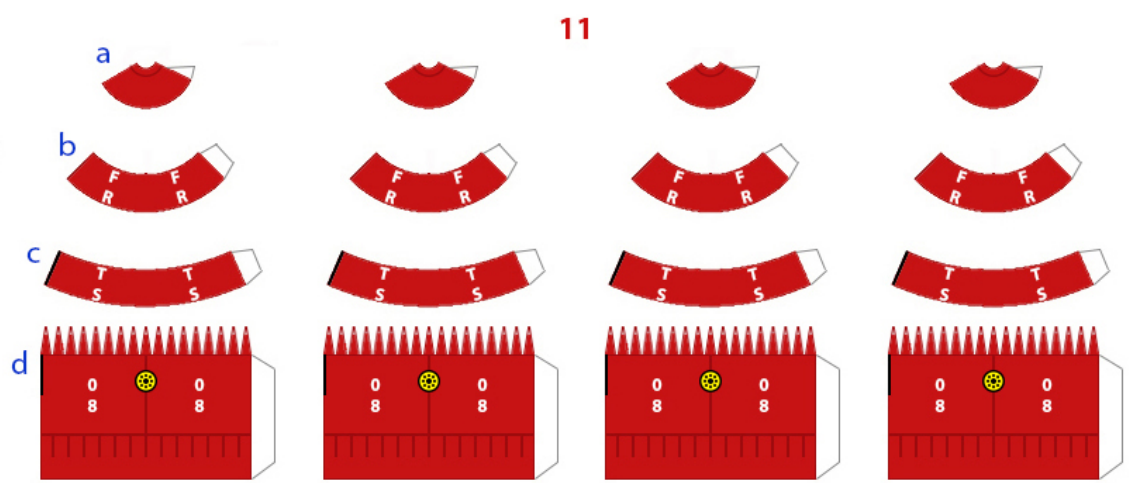

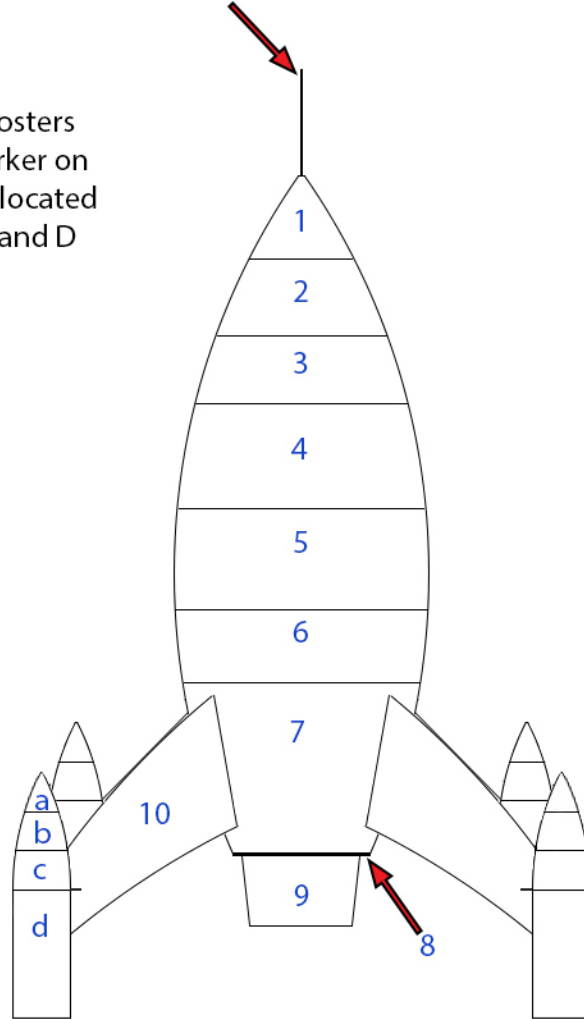
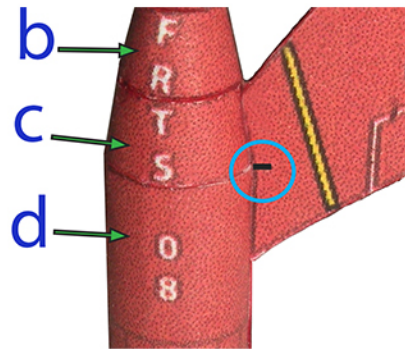
## Keep all seems aligned during assembly

Fins (Part 10) are glued on the red lines on part 7.

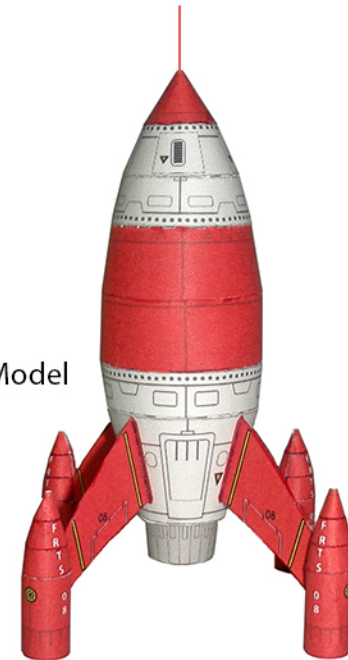
Part 8 is glued at the bottom.

The fins are glued onto the four boosters at the vertical seems. The black marker on the small end of the fins should be located on the glue seem between parts C and D as shown on the photo below.

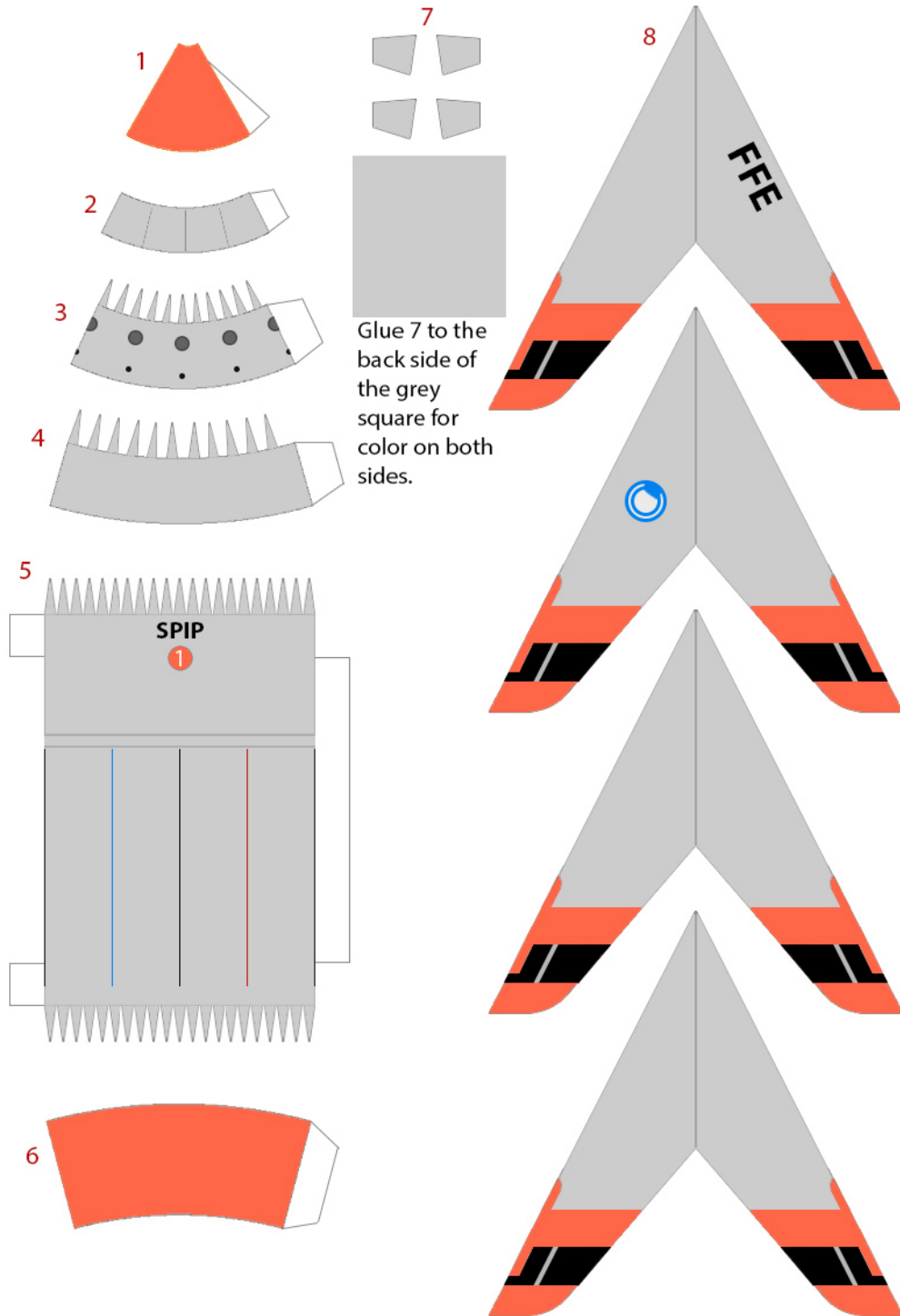
Plastic broom straw or music wire cut at 14mm long, colored red.

# Retro Rocket 3



Glue 7 to the back side of the grey square for color on both sides.

## Instructions

Keep all seems aligned during assembly.  
7 is glued on the four lines on part 2.

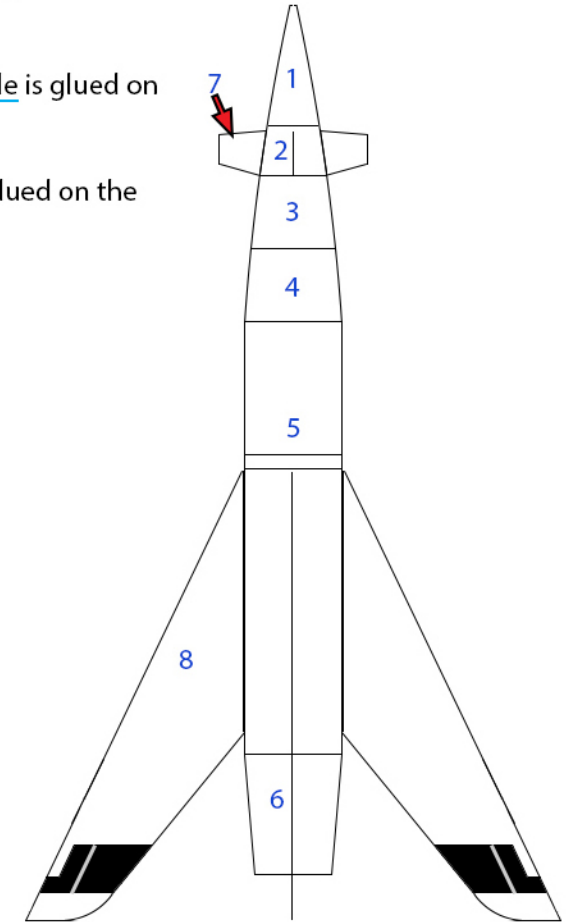
Part 8 with "FFE" print is glued on the red line on part 5.

Part 8 with the blue circle is glued on the blue line on part 5.

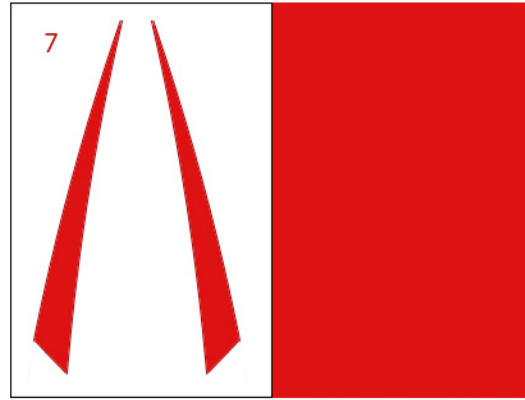
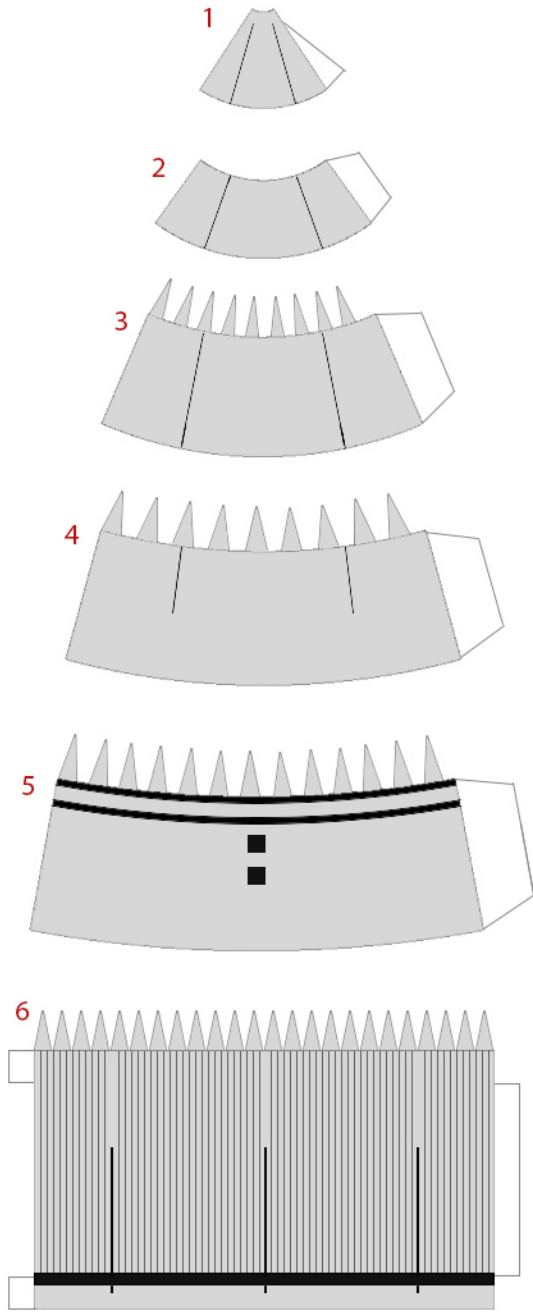
The other two fins are glued on the black lines on part 5.



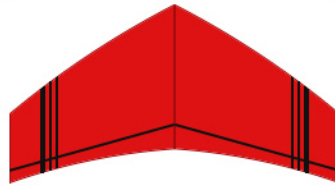
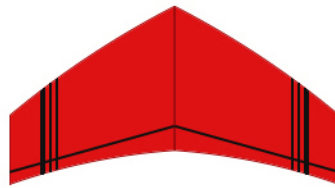
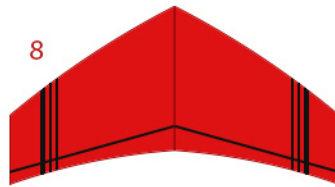

# Retro Rocket 4

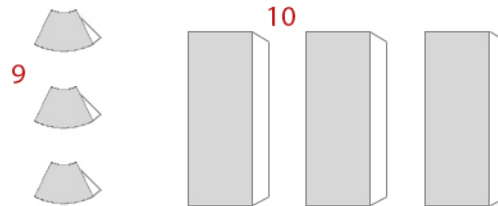


Fold at the middle back-to-back and glue together, cut out the parts for color on both sides.



Need 3 wood skewers, close to 3mm diameter (0.12 inch), cut at 29mm long, colored light grey or silver.

OR use parts 9 and 10 below.



## Instructions

Keep all seems aligned during assembly.

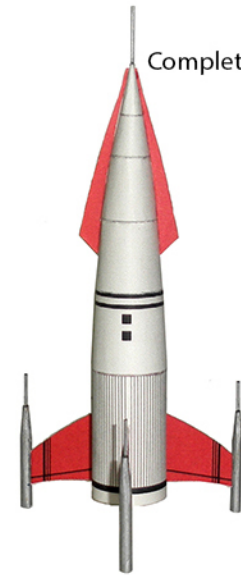
Glue 7 on the black lines on parts 1-4.

Roll 9 and 10 to cones and tubes, glue 9 on top of 10. OR prepare the wood skewers and plastic brooms straws according to the instructions and glue together.

Glue these to the fins. Bottom of the fins should be up 7 mm from the bottom of the skewers, see below.

Glue the fins (part 8) to the black lines near the bottom (part 6).

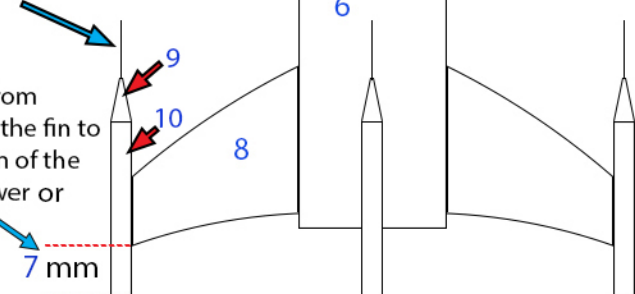
Plastic broom straw or music wire cut at 14mm long, colored light grey or silver.

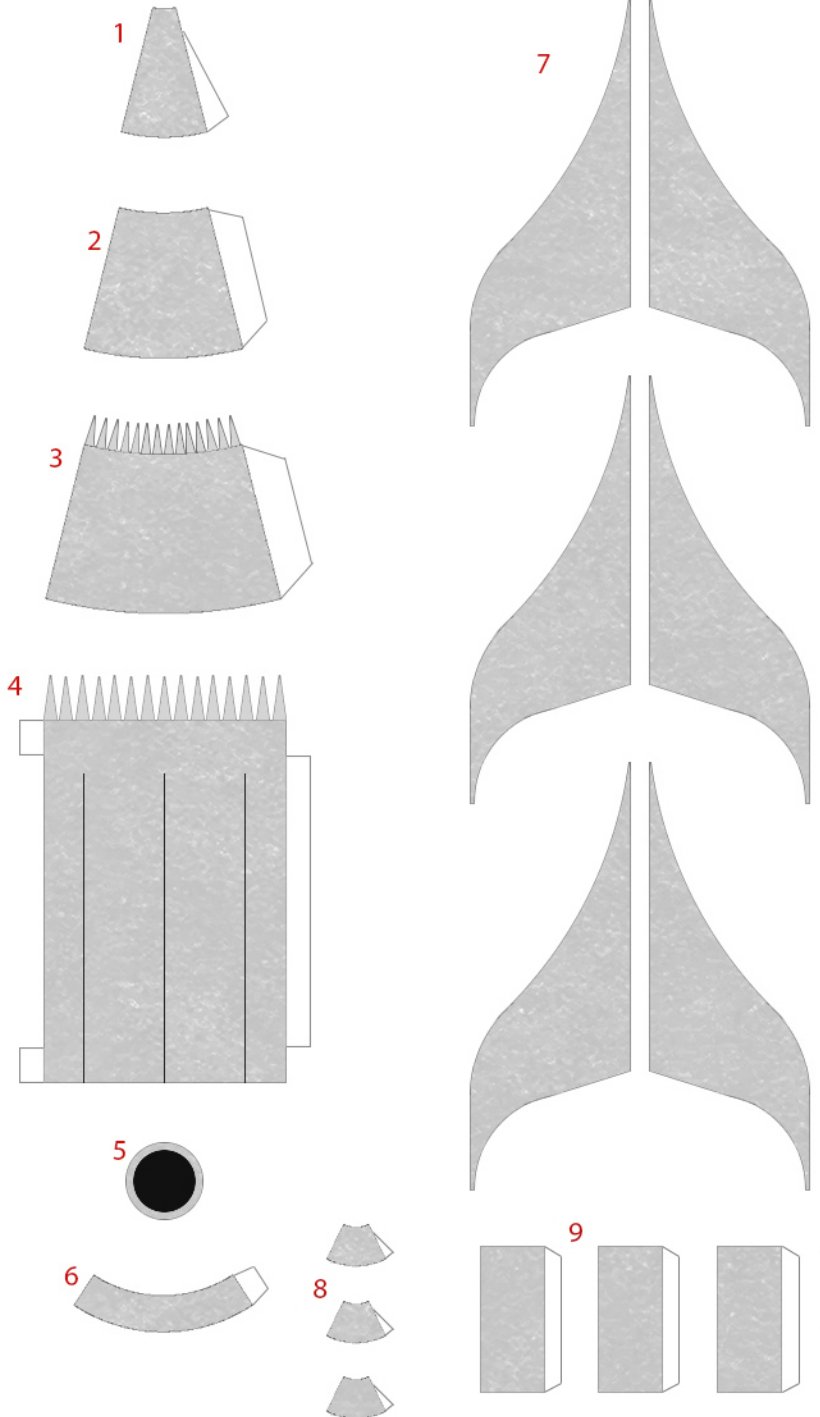
Plastic broom straw or music wire cut at 8mm long, colored light grey or silver. Make 3.

Distance from bottom of the fin to the bottom of the wood skewer or parts 9-10



# Retro Rocket 5

Glue each pair of fins back-to-back



## Instructions

Keep all seems aligned during assembly

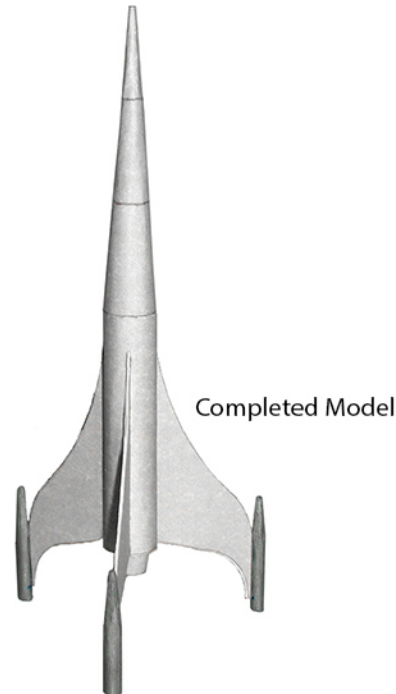
Roll-glue parts 8 and 9 into small cones and tubes, glue 8 on top of 9. Or use 3 wood skewer close to 3mm in diameter (0.12 inch), cut at 25 mm long, colored light grey or silver.

Glue 5 to the bottom of the main body.

Glue 6 (Nozzle) to part 5 - see pic below.

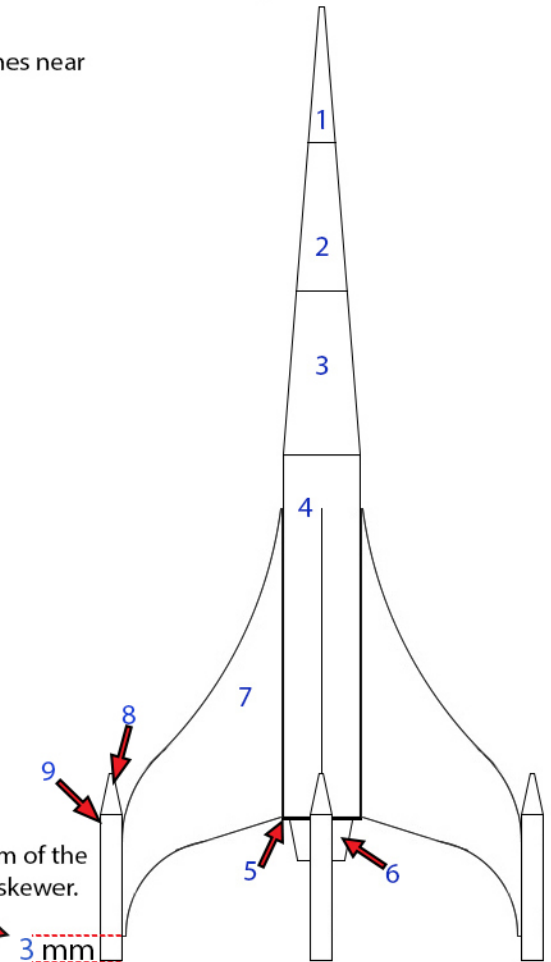
Fold-glue the fins back-to-back. Glue assembly 8-9 or from the wood skewers to the small end of each fin. The bottom of 8-9 or skewer should be around 3 mm below the bottom of the fin - see diagram below.

Glue each fin assembly to the black lines near the bottom on part 4.

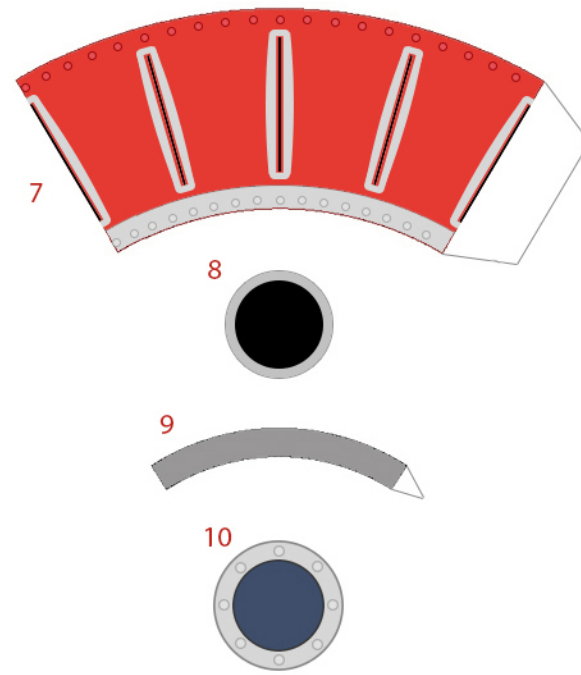
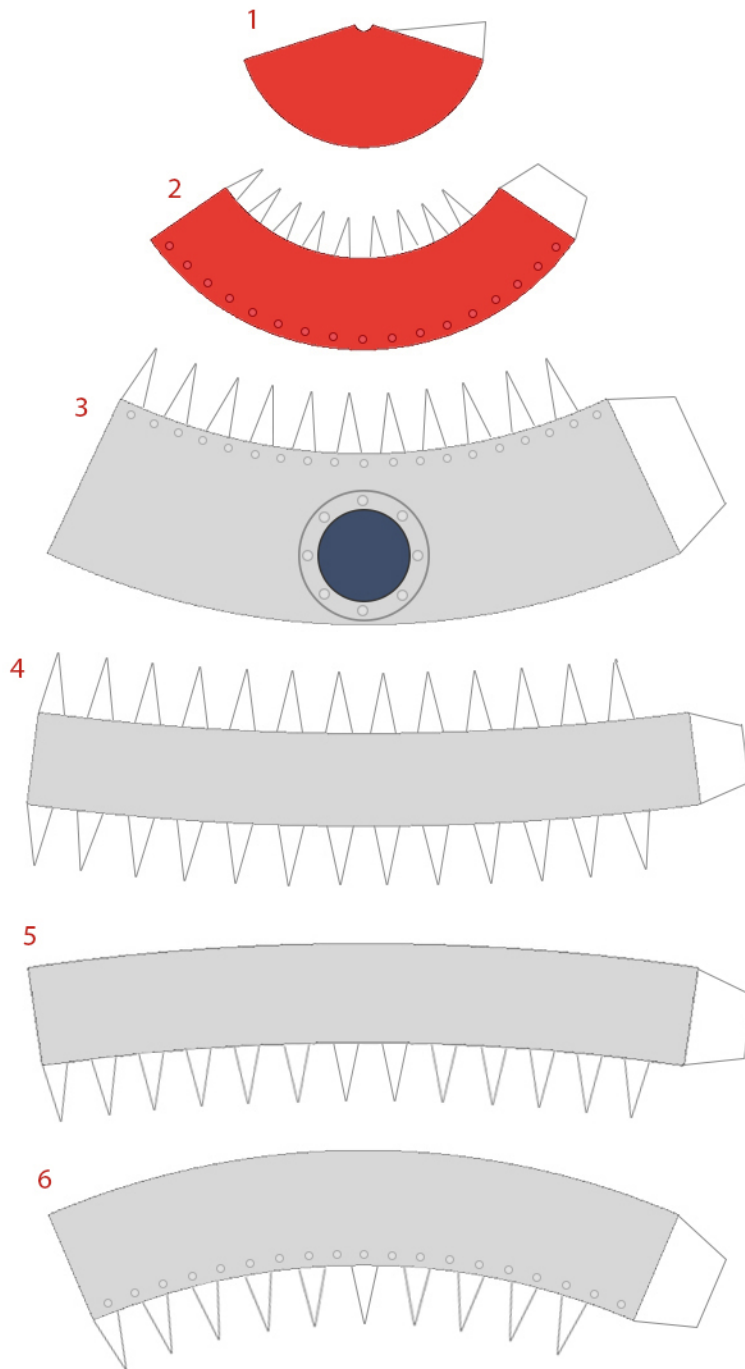

Distance from the bottom of the fin to the bottom of the skewer or part 8 - 9.



# Retro Rocket 6



Glue 10 to the matching graphics on part 3.

Glue one side of parts 11 to cardstock, then glue the other side to make three layers - make four of these.

## Instructions

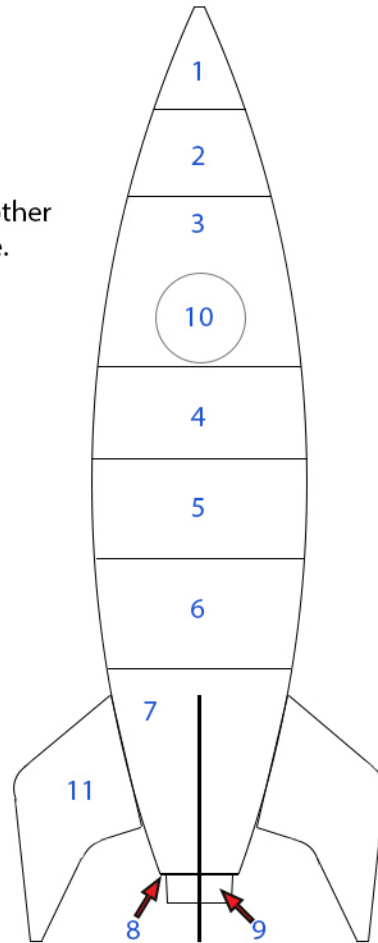
Keep all seems aligned during assembly.

Glue 10 to the matching graphics on 3.

Glue 8 to the bottom, then the nozzle (part 9).

glue one side of the fins to cardstock, then the other side for a three-layered part - make four of these.

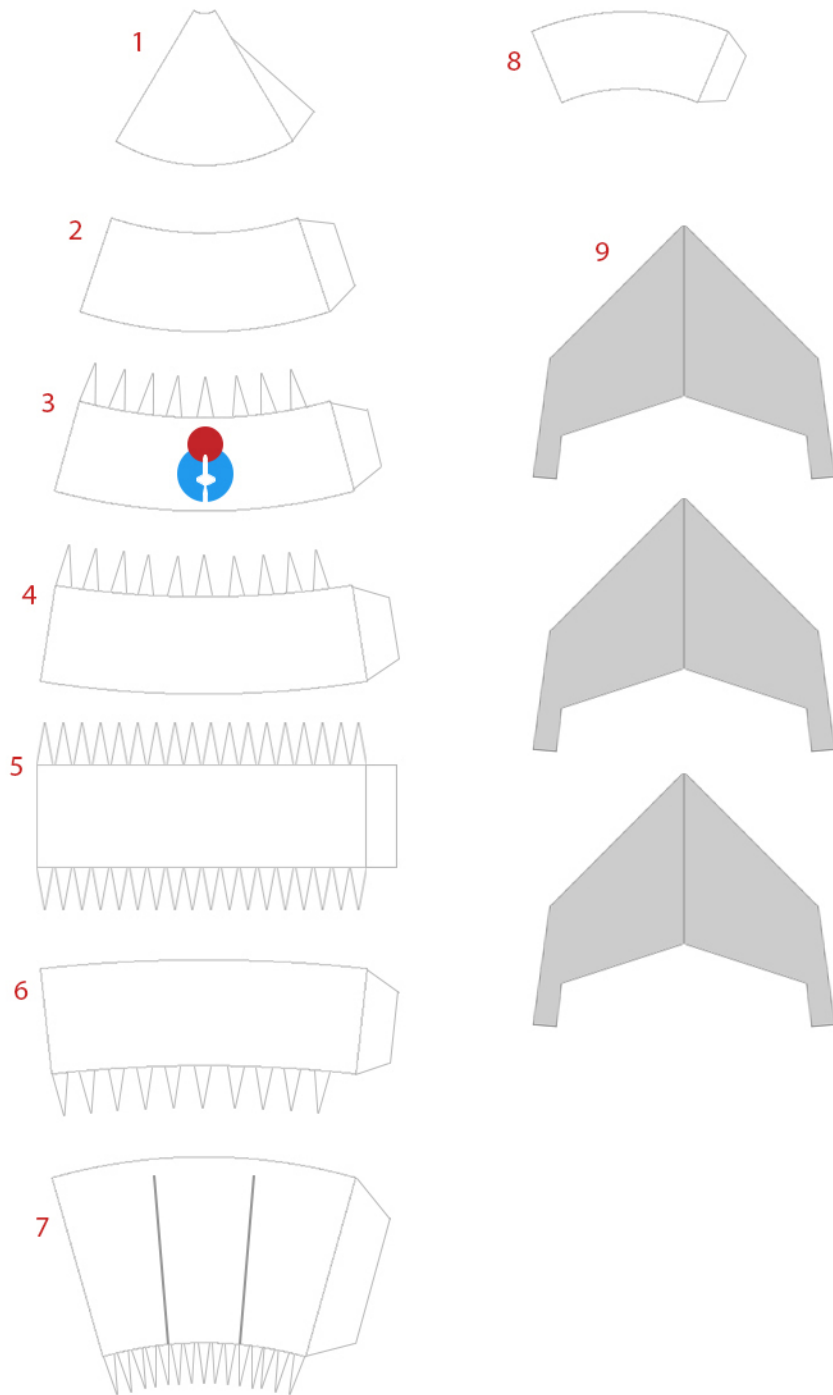
Glue each fin to the black-red stripe on part 7.

Glue part 9 to the bottom of the rocket, then the nozzle.

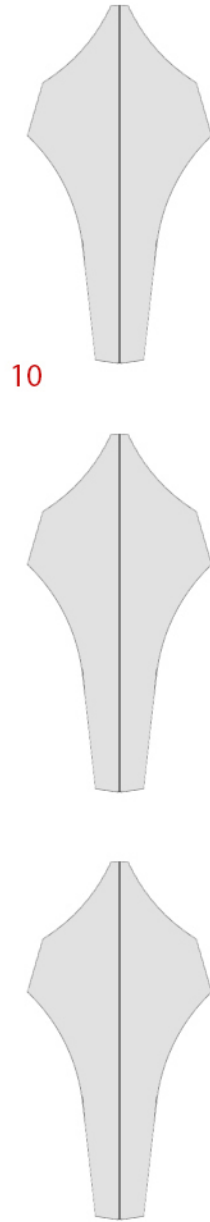
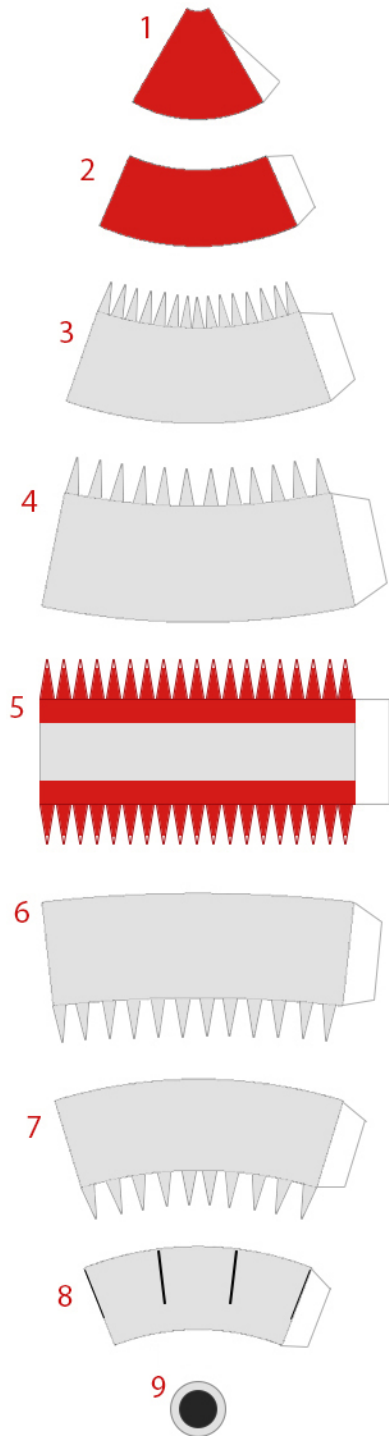

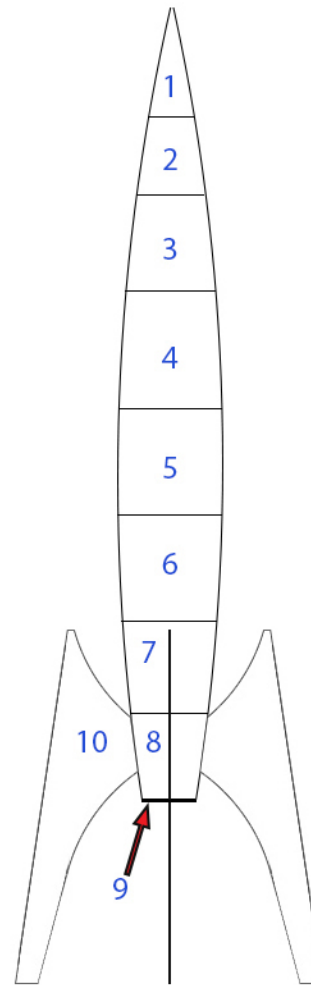

Glue part 9 to the bottom of the rocket (Part 8).

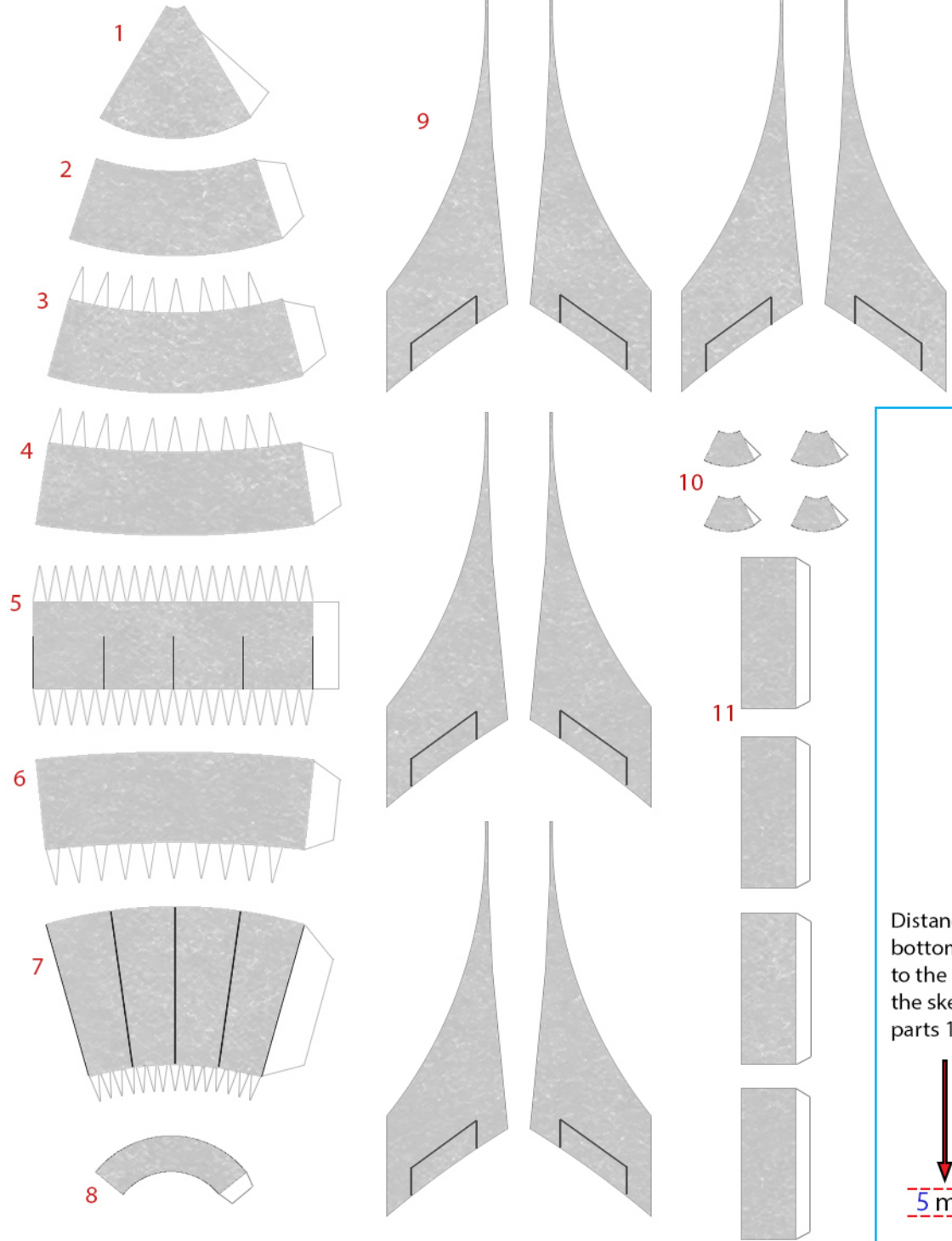
Fold- glue the fins back-to-back, glue each one to one of the 3 black lines near the bottom (part 8).

# Retro Rocket 10



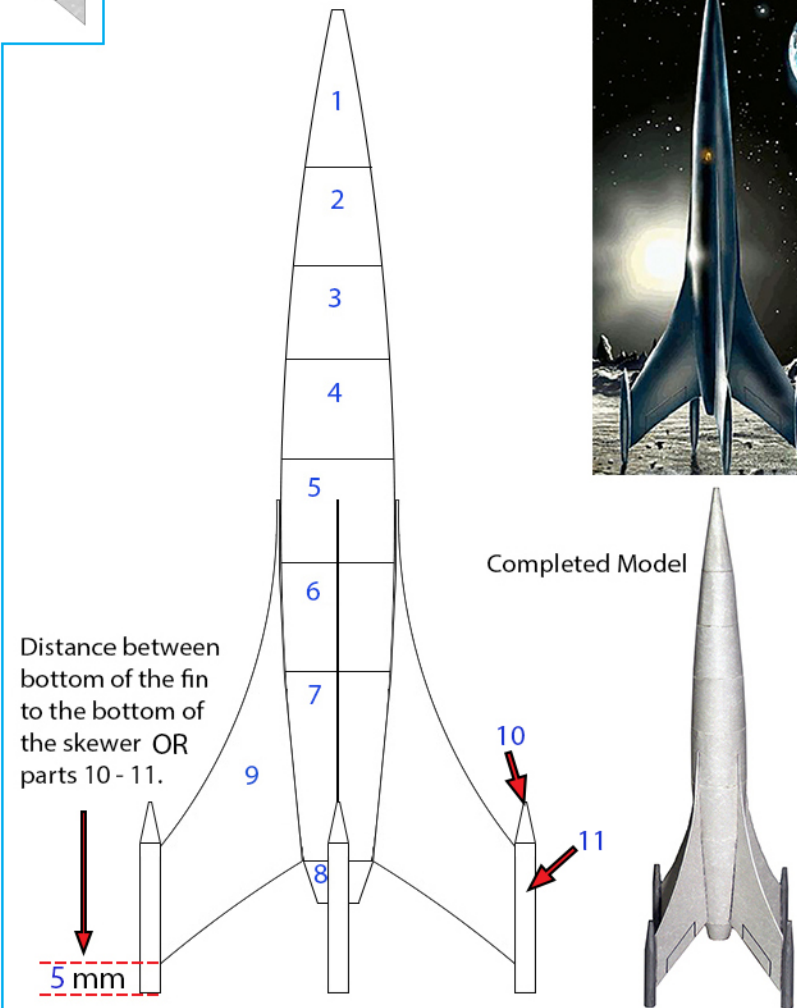
## Instructions

Keep all seems aligned during assembly.  
Glue each pair on fins back-to-back.

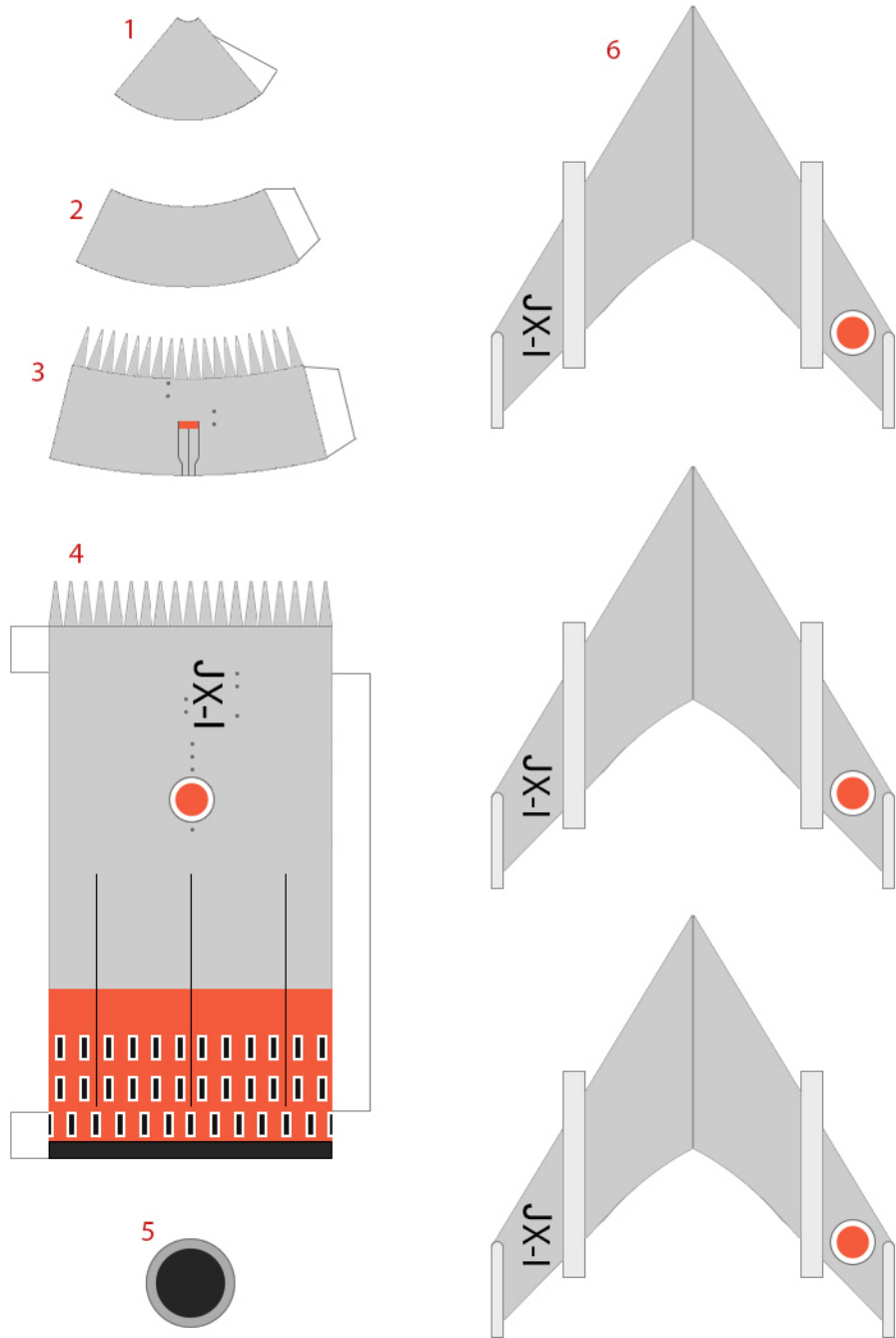
Roll-glue parts 10 and 11 to small cones and tubes, glue 10 on top of 11. OR use 4 wood skewers close to 3 mm diameter (0.12 inch) cut at 25 mm long colored light grey or silver.

Glue these to the small end of the fins, the bottom of the skewers should be around 4 mm below the bottom of the fin, see the diagram below.

Use the black lines of parts 5 and 7 as a guide to glue the fins onto the body.



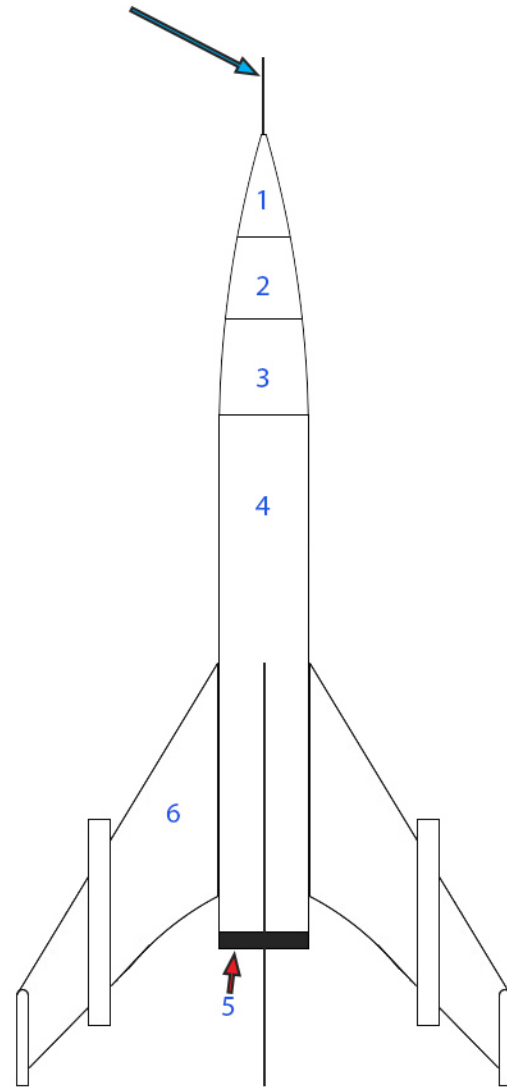
# Retro Rocket 11



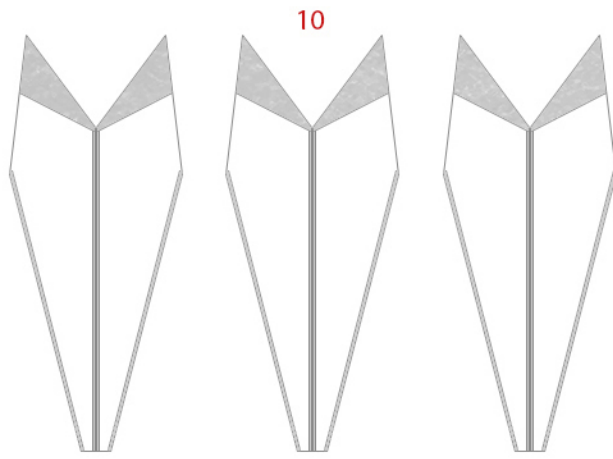
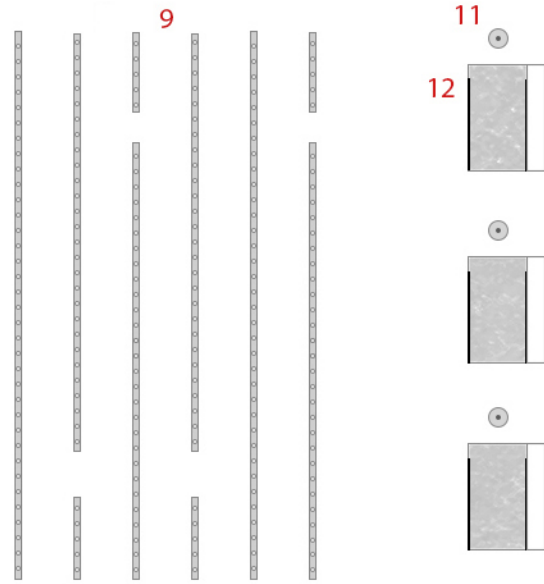
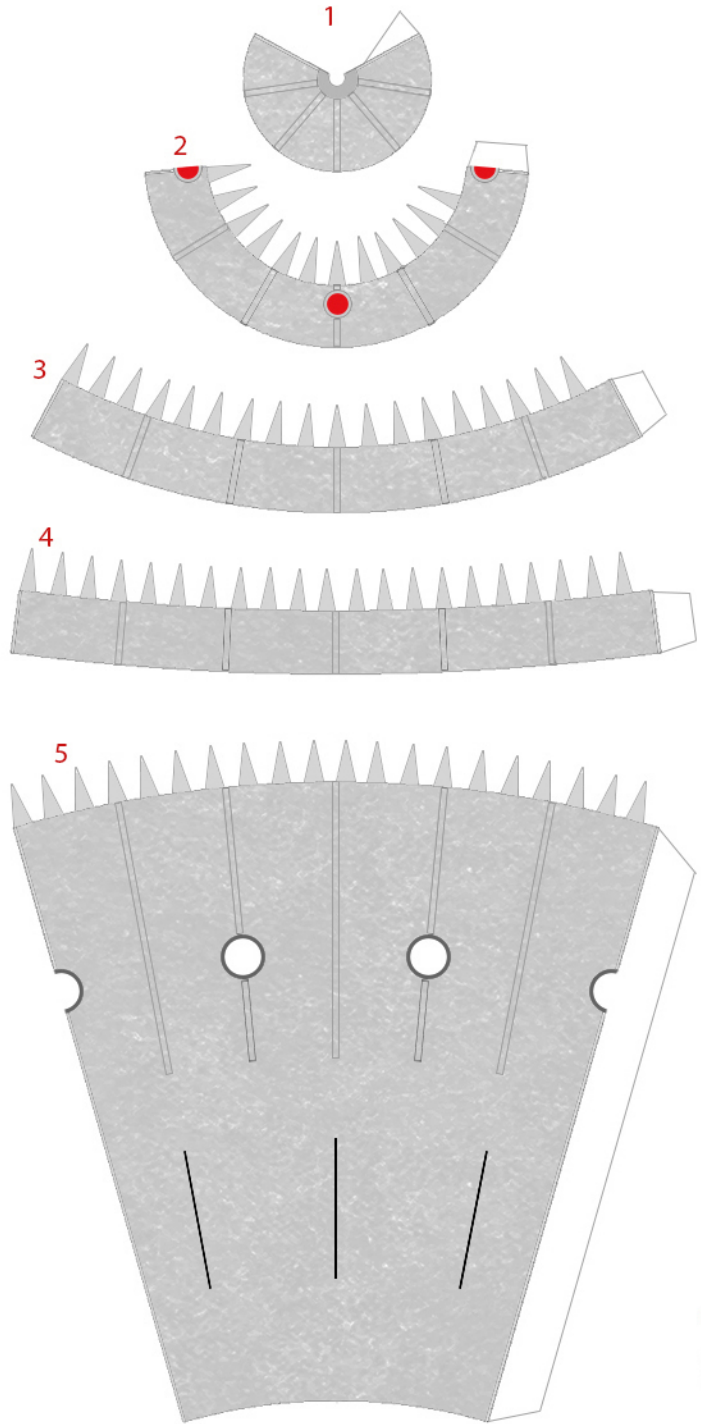
## Instructions

Keep all seams aligned during assembly.

Glue part 5 on the bottom of the rocket (part 4).  
Fold-glue the fins in half, glue to the black lines on part 4.  
Need plastic broom straw, music wire or similar material cut at 10 mm long, colored light grey or silver and glue to the top of the rocket as indicated by the blue arrow.

# Retro Rocket 12

## Instructions

Keep all seems or graphics aligned during the body assembly.

Glue part 6 to the bottom of the body.

Glue parts 7 and 8 to the matching graphics.

Glue 9 on the body matching the strip graphics on the body.

Fold-glue the fins in half.

Roll-glue 12 into tubes, glue 11 on the top (As drawn on the parts sheet). Glue each onto the long side to a fin on the black line on part 12 (see the graphic to the right).

Glue the fins onto the black lines near the bottom of the body (Part 5).

Cut three plastic broom straws, music wire or similar material at 10 mm long, colored light grey or silver. Glue them to the black dot on part 11 on the top of 12 (see the graphic on the right).

Cut one plastic broom straw, music wire or similar material at 27mm long, colored light grey or silver. Glue to the top of the rocket - your model is done.
